**IN YOUR LETTER ASK FOR SETBACKS FROM YOUR PROPERTY!**

All Aggregate Resource Extraction and reclamation activities shall be:

- prohibited within 800 meters of a parcel districted Country Residential (subdivision)
- prohibited within 400 meters of an individual residence

All Aggregate Resource crushing, wash plant, asphalt plant activities shall be:

- prohibited within 1500 meters of a parcel districted Country Residential (subdivision)
- prohibited within 800 meters of an individual residence

All Aggregate Extraction Activities shall be prohibited within 1.5 times the depth of the extraction and the property line to preserve the stability of the adjacent land.

All Aggregate Extraction & Processing Activities shall be prohibited within 800 meters of lakes, rivers, wetlands and other sensitive areas.

**CONSIDERABLE CITIZEN INPUT IS NEEDED TO HAVE THESE BYLAWS REVISED.**
